Alf was a founder member of the Shaggy Dogs along with Cap Smith, Don Wilcox, Fred Price, Jim Curtis, and Ossie Beynon. He was instrumental in naming the club, and designed the logo as he did for the main club. Alf lived in Boldmere, and was born in a water mill which was somewhere near the site of the 9th Tee.
