#### Medal

We played a medal off the yellow tees on Friday 20 August. It was good to see **Doug Corfield** and **Tim Rafferty** at the head of the field, both on a very good 58 strokes. Doug was the winner courtesy of countback.

Right: What do you do when your ball ends up in a tree? Richard Nicholls had this problem on the 13th hole.

You can of course play the ball as it lies, but the best course of action is to take relief for one penalty stroke under rule 19.

This gives you three options, go back and replay the shot, take "back on the line relief" or take lateral relief within two clubs length from the spot on the ground immediatley below the ball.

Do note that before you take any of these options, you must identify the ball as yours, so if its not in reach, you will have to climb up the tree!
